Dro.Me.A. Racing celebrates World Peace Day with 5k run

Dro.Me.A. Racing will be celebrating the UN-declared World Peace Day with a series of activities at Athalassa National Park in Nicosia, on Saturday, September 12. Featuring Dro.Me.A.'s 7th annual 5-km race, an 800-m children's run and entertainment, this fund-raising event aspires to convey a message of wellness and a non-violent culture within families, society and the state.

'The event resonates with our philosophy that sports facilitate a culture of respect for fellow human beings and the environment,' said Dro.Me.A.'s president Nikolas Sourmelis, adding that 'this further enhances friendship and solidarity.'

The event is co-organized by Aglantzia Municipality, PASYKAF (Cyprus Association of Cancer Patients and Friends) and SPAVO (Association for the Prevention and Handling of Violence in the Family). What's more, ANAKYKLOS and BAFA (Bikers Against Family Violence) associations will offer interactive activities and entertainment to children.

The 5-km run kicks off at 08.30 am at the park's Latsia entrance (near the Nicosia General Hospital roundabout). Runners aged 16 years old and above may participate in the 5-km race. Registrations can be made online at www.dromearacing.com, as well as on the day of the race between 7:30 - 8:15 am for a 5 Euro fee. Part of the fees will be donated to PASYKAF (Parent consent is required for those under the age of 18).

The children's run, which kicks off at 09.20 am, is open to children up to 15 years old. Registrations will take place on race day between 07.30-08.15 am. There is no entry fee while a signed consent by a parent or guardian is required.

The event is supported by the CSO and Webarts and it is under the auspices of KOEAS.
